# License Agreement

## For SAS® Software for final thesis

This Master License Agreement (hereinafter: **"Agreement"**) is entered in Germany and governs the license of SAS® Software from SAS Institute GmbH (hereinafter: **"SAS"**) by the individual signing this Agreement (hereinafter: **"User"**).

### 1. License Grant.

- 1.1. SAS grants User a nonexclusive, nonassignable, and nontransferable license and use the SAS® Software specified in the Supplement hereto (hereinafter: **"Software"**) free of charge. User may install the Software only in Croatia on workstation hardware owned or leased by User.
- 1.2. The Software may only be accessed by User. Use of the Software is limited to the purpose of writing a thesis. User may not use the Software for any business operations or administrative processes whatsoever. Third parties may not access and use the Software. User will be liable for any access of the software in violation of this Agreement.
- 1.3. User is not authorised to install or attempt to use other products that may be contained on the media received from SAS.
- 1.4. Title to the Software and its documentation and ownership of all copyrights remains with SAS Institute Inc., Cary, North Carolina, U.S.A. and its licensors at all times. Copyright notices and other proprietary rights notices in the Software may not be deleted or modified. This Agreement does not transfer any ownership rights.
- 1.5. Source code from which the Software object code is derived (hereinafter **"Source Code"**) is not being provided and is a trade secret of SAS Institute Inc. to which access is not authorised. Except to the extent and in the circumstances expressly required to be permitted by law (and even in such circumstances not without first requesting relevant information from SAS), neither User nor any other third party may reverse assemble, disassemble, or decompile the Software or otherwise attempt to recreate the Source Code.
- 1.6. User acknowledges and agrees that SAS will keep records of User's personal data provided in connection with this Agreement for SAS' marketing and other purposes. SAS assures that it will not make available personal data to any third party, except as required by law.

### 2. Reference.

In exchange for the license granted subject to section 1. above, User agrees to explicitly reference SAS and the Software licensed by User in the bibliography of User's thesis document and shall provide SAS with a free copy of the thesis document within two month following the acceptance of the thesis document by the institution on whose behalf or request the thesis has been written.

### 3. No Technical Support.

SAS does not provide any technical support for the Software.

### 4. No Warranty.

SAS warrants it has the right to license the Software. Otherwise, THE SOFTWARE IS PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT ANY WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED.

### 5. Limitations of Liability.

Neither SAS nor SAS Institute Inc. is liable for (1) special, incidental, direct or indirect, consequential, including, but not limited to loss of profits, loss of data, regeneration of data, and punitive damages (arising in contract or tort), or (2) any claim against User by a third party. The limitations in this Section do not include limitations of liability for personal injury and death.

**6. Indemnification.**

- 6.1. If a claim of copyright, patent, trade secret, or other intellectual property rights violation is made against User relating to the Software, User agrees to immediately notify SAS, allow SAS to control the litigation or settlement of such claim, and cooperate with SAS in the investigation, defense, and/or settlement thereof. SAS agrees to take control of the litigation and indemnify User by paying any settlement approved by SAS, or any judgment, costs, or legal fees finally awarded against User for such claim. User may participate at User's own expense. This indemnification obligation does not apply to the extent the claim is based on a combination of SAS Software with other software or a User modification to the Software if such claim would not have been made but for the combination or modification.
- 6.2. If such a claim is made User agrees to abide by the SAS' decision regarding the use of the Software and, if appropriate, install a different version of the Software or stop using the Software.

**7. Termination.**

The license will automatically terminate on the date of final delivery of the thesis agreed with the institution on whose behalf or request such thesis was written, or at the end of the license period specified in the Supplement, whichever occurs first. SAS may terminate the license for a breach of this Agreement if not cured within thirty days of written notice by SAS. Obligations in this Agreement, which by their nature are continuing, survive termination. Upon termination of the license, or when a User is no longer authorised to access the Software, User agrees to return, or delete, or destroy respectively the Software product at issue.

**8. Modifications and Amendments.**

This Agreement is the parties' complete and exclusive statement relating to their subject matter. Modifications must be in writing, signed by both parties, and specifically reference this Agreement. Additional or different terms on current or future Customer or third party purchasing documents are expressly objected to and rejected.

**9. Governing Law.**

The Laws of Germany govern this Agreement. Because the Software is of United States origin, United States export regulations govern its use, and User agrees to prevent access to the Software by persons in or from countries embargoed by the United States or otherwise prohibited from accessing the Software.

**10. General.**

Failure to require compliance with a part of this Agreement is not a waiver of that part. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any part unenforceable, that part is excluded, but the rest of the Agreement stays in full force and effect. Any attempt by User to transfer or assign this Agreement is void.
